THE BUILDING FOR KIDS — 100 W. College Ave. This children’s museum is a great place for the young-, and young-at-heart.

ATLAS MILL — 425 W. Water St. — Stop for a beautiful view of the river.

THE HISTORY MUSEUM AT THE CASTLE — 330 E. College Ave. Learn about Appleton’s heritage at this unique museum.

THE DOWNTOWN TROLLEY SCHEDULE

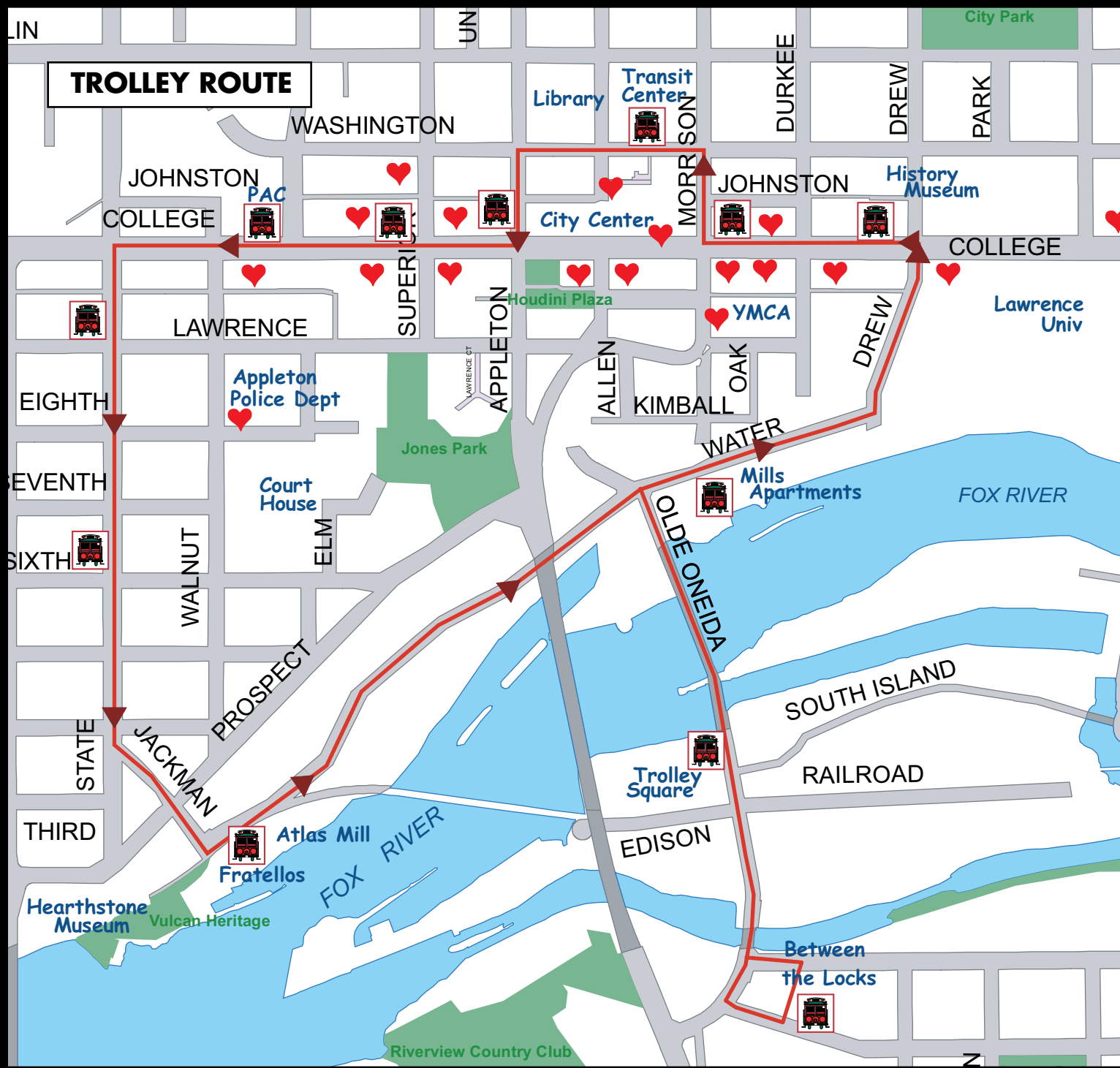
