



WI SHRM STATE COUNCIL ENTERPRISING LEADERSHIP GRANT APPLICATION 2019

The WI SHRM Enterprising Leadership Grant was established in 2008. It awards a chapter or chapters a grant to support a "partnership" with another WI-based organization that promotes communication and collaboration between HR and other business professionals/organizations across the state. It funds initiatives that are innovative and strive to bring business professionals together toward a common cause, led by the HR community.

Up to \$6,000 is available for Wisconsin SHRM Chapter(s) to implement an activity or initiative in the area of Enterprising HR Leadership. Criteria include having 1) a partnership with an organization outside the SHRM that has goals/objectives that help advance the HR profession and 2) a joint planned activity or initiative with that organization that demonstrates Enterprising HR Leadership Communication, Collaboration and/or Education of/between business professionals.

Chapter Name:

- 1. Provide the name and history of the organization with whom your chapter has partnered. How long have you partnered with them? What is their mission? How does their work advance the HR Profession and the WI business community?
- 2. Describe the activity/initiative on which you will be partnering. Be specific, including planned outcomes, task/responsible parties, timelines, etc. (Feel free to include attachments). What are your main objectives? How does this mutually benefit your chapter and the partnering organization? How does it demonstrate communication, collaboration and/or education?
- 3. Include a budget for how the grant money would be spent. Include an estimate of how many individuals would be impacted by your activity/initiative to calculate the cost per person served.
